

# Info Leaflet

## Programme "Perspektive Aufstieg" (PPA) winter semester 2023/24 Application period starts on 30.05.2023 until 28.07.2023

- The programme consists of three essential parts:
  - 1. Language
    - → B1, B2, C1
  - 2. Field of Studies

 $\rightarrow$  from B2 onwards: participation in lectures, seminars, tutorials for "standard students"

 $\rightarrow$  possibility to take exams and count the credits towards your academic achievements when re-registering for your course of studies

Integration ("Glückauf!"-course)
→ Various seminars/workshops/guided tours (e.g. office workshop, guided tours in the German Mining Museum and many more).

→ You have to take part in at least 2 meetings of the "Glückauf!"-courses to be allowed to take the final exam. For every participation you will receive a signature. You are welcome to participate in more than 2 meetings.

- The German courses are expected to start on 02.10.2023.
- Every course is 15 hours per week.
- Schedules are different for every course. You will be assigned to a class about three weeks before the start of the courses.
- Student ID/ NRW ticket costs about 240 Euro per semester. The German courses are free.
- From B2 onwards it is possible that the PPA bears the costs for one of these official language exams: DSH / Telc C1 Hochschule / C1 Goethe

## **Requirements for participation**

- International prospective students with or without Refugee status
- Proof of Higher Education Entrance Qualification (Abitur) abroad which would allow you to study there
- Intention to study at the Technische Hochschule Georg Agricola
- Participation in the German-placement test ("Einstufungstest") of the PPA

### How can I apply?

These are the steps for application:

- 1. Please send us the following documents to application-ppa@thga.de:
  - Abitur certificate in the original language and translated into German or English
  - Residence permit (front and back) or identity card
  - CV
  - If available: Proof of study (transcript of records, degree certificate from the studies)
  - in the original language and translated into German or English
  - If available: language certificate from the last successfully completed German course



- 1. We will review your documents.
- 2. If your documents are complete and fulfil the requirements, we will send you an online appointment.
- 3. After your application you will be invited to a German-placement test. The test determines your language level in our programme.
- 4. When you received the result of your placement test, you can decide whether you accept it and join the programme.
